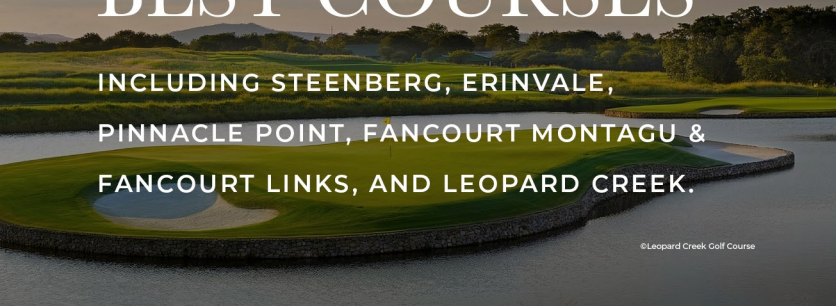

From leopard moving silently through the bush to elephant herds at the water's edge, this is safari at its most immersive.





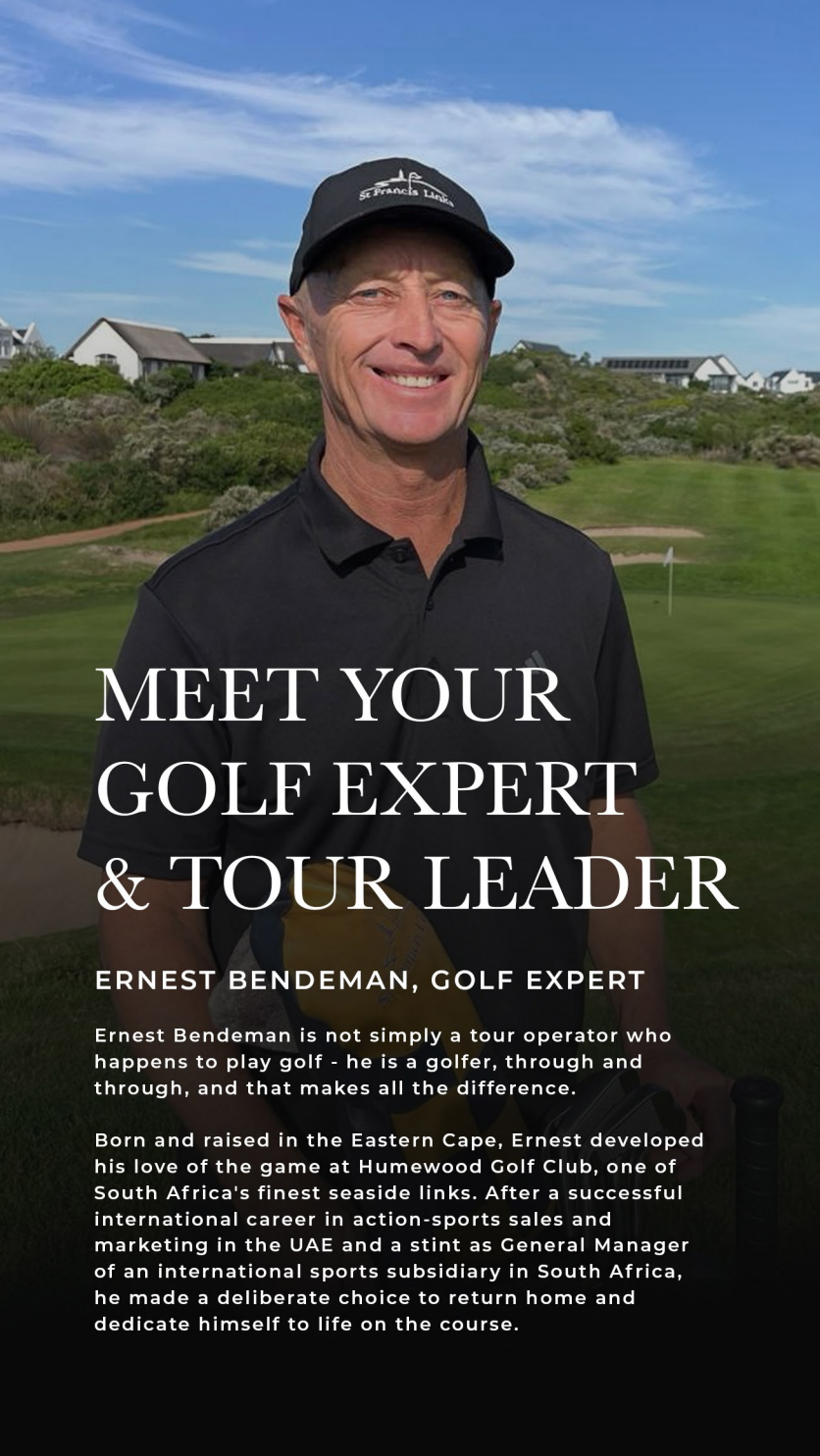

SUMMARY ITINERARY

DAY 1

Touch down at Cape Town International Airport where a VIP Meet & Greet and seamless assistance through Immigration and Customs awaits before your private transfer to the iconic V&A Waterfront.

DAY 2

After a leisurely breakfast, embark on a privately guided tour to the iconic Robben Island, where South Africa's journey to freedom is brought to life in a way that is equal parts sobering and inspiring.

Back on the mainland, ascend Table Mountain via cable car for sweeping 360-degree views across the Cape Peninsula and beyond.



This evening, savour a memorable dinner paired with exceptional Cape wines at a celebrated V&A Waterfront favourite, a perfect end to a day steeped in history and natural wonder.

DAY 3

Tee off at the acclaimed Steenberg Golf Club, set against the dramatic backdrop of the Constantia Valley and the Steenberg mountains.

From there, make your way to Boulders Beach, home to one of the world's few land-based colonies of the endangered African penguin.



The return journey winds along the breathtaking Chapman's Peak Drive, one of the most scenic coastal roads on earth, with sheer cliff faces plunging into the Atlantic far below.

DAY 4

Bid farewell to Cape Town as you head into the heart of the Stellenbosch Winelands.

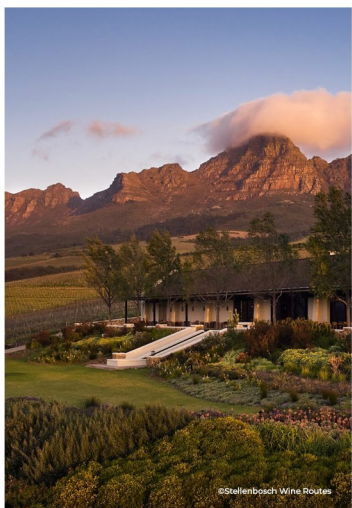


Check in to the landmark Lanzerac Hotel & Spa and sit down to a gourmet dinner at the celebrated Manor Kitchen.

Enjoy a round of drinks at the spectacular Pinnacle Point Clubhouse, with the coastline as your backdrop, before a transfer to the legendary dinner at Fancourt Hotel & Spa, one of South Africa's most iconic five-star golf resorts and your home for the days ahead.

DAY 7

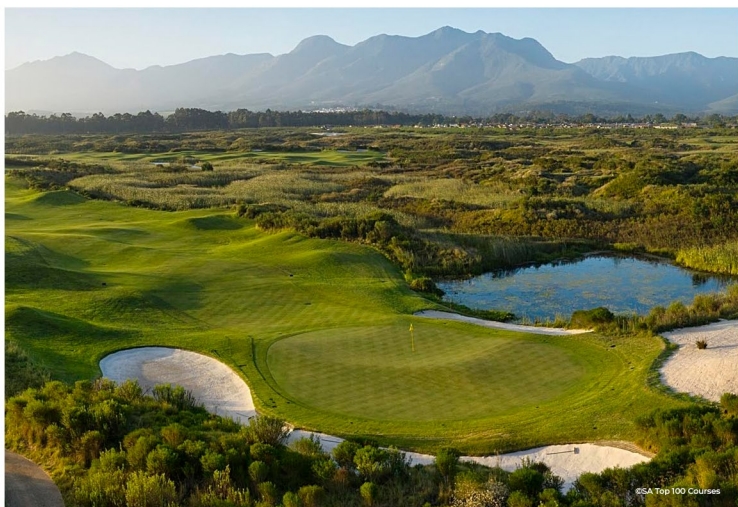
This morning, tee off on the renowned Montagu Course at Fancourt - a Gary Player design widely regarded as one of the finest parkland courses in South Africa, set against the striking Outeniqua mountains.



For those seeking adventure beyond the fairway, an optional sightseeing excursion to the charming town of Oudtshoorn offers a fascinating glimpse into the heart of the Klein Karoo, including a visit to the awe-inspiring Cango Caves, one of the world's great natural wonders, and an authentic ostrich farm where the famous feathered residents of the region take centre stage.

As the sun sets over the fairways, the group comes together for dinner at Fancourt's signature restaurant, an unhurried evening of exceptional food and fine wine.

DAY 8



Today is reserved for something truly special. The Links at Fancourt - consistently ranked as Africa's premier golf course - awaits. Modelled on the great coastal links of the British Isles yet unmistakably African in character, this is a round that will live long in the memory. Expect an exhilarating test of shot-making, an immaculate course in impeccable condition, and a sense of occasion that few courses anywhere in the world can match.

After the final putt, gather at The Links Clubhouse to relive the round over some drinks, and enjoy a casual dinner with great company, and the quiet satisfaction of having played one of the finest courses on earth.

DAY 9

After breakfast, check out and transfer to George Airport for your flight to Skukuza - the gateway to the southern reaches of the great Kruger National Park. As the bush closes in around you, the shift from fairways to wilderness is immediate and electric.

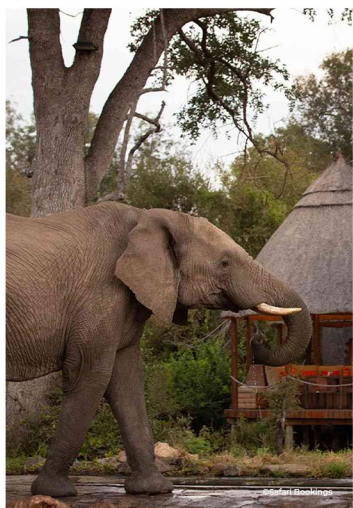


Check in at Lukimbi Safari Lodge, a private concession within Kruger offering exclusive access to some of the park's most pristine and wildlife-rich terrain. There is barely time to settle in before your first safari drive sets out into the golden afternoon light, eyes wide, senses alive, and the African bush unfolding in all its raw and breathtaking splendour.

As night falls over the bush, gather for dinner under the stars, the sounds of the African night your soundtrack, and the magic of Kruger all around you.

DAY 10

Rise before dawn for a morning safari drive deep into Kruger National Park, where the early light reveals the bush at its most alive, predators, elephant herds, and the extraordinary theatre of the African wilderness unfolding at every turn.



Return to Lukimbi for a leisurely midday before heading out once more as the afternoon heat softens, the golden hours offering an entirely different and equally spectacular chapter.

Dinner this evening is unhurried and convivial, set against the incomparable backdrop of the African night.

DAY 11

Today delivers the pinnacle of the golf safari experience - a round at the legendary Leopard Creek Country Club, consistently ranked among the top courses in the world.

With the Crocodile River as its boundary and Kruger stretching endlessly beyond, hippo, elephant, and crocodile are regular companions on these remarkable fairways.

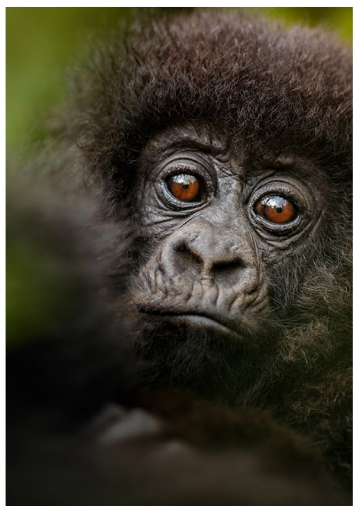


Following the round, one final safari drive offers a last, unhurried farewell to the bush before returning to Lukimbi as the sun descends.
